(Date of report to WG Board was March 18, 2025) This has been a fairly typical spring, with 40° temperature swings, a little snow and a lot of wind. The crew has been busy with tree removal and clean-up. There are still a lot of branches to pick up prior to mowing, which should be happening in a couple of weeks.

We have already changed cups once and mowed greens twice. The greens will be verticut and top-dressed soon, to get rid of winter ball marks. Will hopefully fire up the irrigation system end of March. We will also be putting down spring fertilizer over the entire campus sometime in late March. Our 3-way fertilizer with pre-emergent and grub control will go down early May.
