

Our spring fertilizer, crabgrass preventer and grub control has been put down throughout campus. With the amount of rain this spring, we continue to do our best just to keep up with the mowing. We apologize if some of the hand work and line trimming gets missed, but we will get to it as often as possible. The mower height has been raised 1" above our normal cut to help prevent as much clumping as possible. This should also help keep things green going into the hot and dry season.

There have been a lot of projects and work requests turned in recently and we will hopefully get to them as the mowing slows down. No Limits tree service will be here by the end of May to help with some requests along with other trees needing trimmed and dead branches removed.
