SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

(Date of report to WG Board was October 18, 2022) A big thank you to those helping water around their homes and the common areas. With the majority of fall seeding complete, it will help to get as much water as possible in the ground and new grass growing before winter. Aside from a couple days here and there, late October and early November forecast looks to remain warm enough to extend the growing season. It is best to water in the heat of the day (2-4 pm) during fall, as this will help keep soil temperatures up and grass growing. It will not hurt to water trees around your homes as well.

Lookahead – There were another 32 stumps ground, so the crew will continue filling holes and seeding as weather permits. We are preparing for the fall leaf season and will be blowing, mulching and vacuuming nonstop to keep campus clean. Our fall clean-up efforts will also consist of trimming dead branches and cutting back suckers. The maintenance crew is in the process of doing the fall fertilizing.

Please remember, starting November 30 you can put leaves and yard waste in with your garbage.
